FULL DAY TOUR: 1



Blue Mosque

Also known as “The Mosque of Sultan Ahmed.” The mosque is popularly known as the Blue Mosque having been named for the blue tiles adorning the walls of its interior. It was built during the rule of Ahmed I. from 1609 to 1616. Istanbul boasts its monumental shrines of different faiths and Blue Mosque is probably one of the most famed masterpieces of Ottoman religious architecture. Standing in great prestige with its six minarets and perfectly proportioned dome, it is named after its Turquoise colored tiles made of quartz minerals.

Hippodrome

Once the vast arena that functioned as the heart of sporting (chariots races and athletics) events and political activities. The Roman Hippodrome of the glorious past displays today the famous Obelisk of Theodosius and the Serpentine Column dating back to 5th century BC. Here you can see the Egyptian Obelisk brought from Egypt by Emperor Theodosius; the Serpentine Column (Tripod of Plataea) from Temple of Apollo at Delphi and the Tiled (Walled) Column erected by Constantine Porphyrogenitus at 10th century AD.



Topkapi Palace Museum

The biggest and one of the most popular sites to visit in Istanbul. It was built in between 1466 and 1478 by the Sultan Mehmet II on top of a hill in a small peninsula, dominating the Golden Horn to the north, the Sea of Marmara to the south, and the Bosphorus strait to the northeast, with great views of the Asian side as well. After the Conquest of Constantinople in 1453, Mehmet II ordered to build this palace in its present location on top of the ancient Byzantine ruins.

Grand Bazaar

The Grand Bazaar (Kapalicarsi in Turkish) is one of the oldest and largest covered markets in the world. It was built from wood around an old Byzantine building after the Conquest of Istanbul. Initially consisted of two warehouses known as Inner Bedesten and Sandal Bedesten, it has gotten larger with the addition of new sections and inns throughout the centuries.



FULL DAY TOUR: 2



Spice Market

Built in 1664, this large, old stone building includes a large number of shops (and a restaurant on the second floor that has long held a venerable place in the life of the city). This collection of shops was actually part of the complex of the adjacent Yeni Camii (the “New Mosque”). Since its construction, the Egyptian Spice Market has specialized in the sale of exotic spices. Today, these lovely small shops continue to sell spices and now also sell dried fruits, nuts, seeds, and other edibles.

St. Sophia

The Church of Divine wisdom and a testament to the sophistication of the 6th Century. The vast edifice was built over two earlier churches and inaugurated by Emperor Justinian in 537. The immense dome is an architectural marvel, as it seems to hover overhead. In addition to admiring the architecture you will also view the wonderful mosaics in the upper galleries.
